Don Sahly



Don Ross Sahly was born January 2, 1943 in Vancouver, British Columbia. At the age of 9, he moved with his parents to the campus of Burman University (then known as Canadian Union College). Don attended the campus school from grade four through academy, followed by three years of college. In the summer of 1964, Don and Weslynn Choban were married and he began his career in teaching and administration in Seventh-day Adventist schools.

Don and Weslynn have 2 children and 4 grandchildren. Their daughter April is a nurse and their son Quentin is a professor in the School of Business at Andrews University, in Berrien Springs, Michigan.

During the 47 years of Don's career, he and Weslynn served twelve years in elementary schools. He also held the positions of Assistant to the Vice President for Development at Andrews University; Principal of the Ekamai International High School

in Bangkok, Thailand; President of the Southeast Asia Union College in Singapore; President of Southern Adventist University; Associate Director for Education at the General Conference; President of Southwestern Adventist University, and President of Griggs University. Don and Weslynn are retired and living in Raleigh, North Carolina and in retirement, Don has served part-time for Adventist Heritage Ministries of the General Conference.

Ron Sydenham and his wife Nicole, both grew up in Montreal, Quebec, were raised in the Catholic Church, and joined the Seventh-day Adventist Church in the summer of 1979. Just a few months after their baptism, Ron felt the call to be a pastor. The two of them packed up and moved to study on the campus of Burman University (then Canadian Union College). After graduating in 1983, they accepted a call to the Weyburn-Estevan District in Saskatchewan. From there, they moved to Andrews University, where Pastor Ron enrolled in the Master of Divinity program.

According to Pastor Ron, ministry is a “team approach.” While he was attending Andrews, Nicole was selling Tupperware and supporting their family of six. When Ron graduated from the program, their family moved back to the Manitoba-Saskatchewan Conference to pastor in the Rosthern,

Prince Albert, and Shellbrook District until 1988, when he was ordained. That same year they accepted a call to the Sherbrooke and Waterville churches in the Quebec Conference. In 1992, they transferred to the Henderson Highway Church in Winnipeg. In 1998, fifteen years after he graduated, they accepted a call to pastor the College Heights Church and blessed the campus with 18 years of friendship, mentorship, and love.

Ron and Nicole still live in Lacombe. They have four adult children (Patrick, Dan, Jon and Veronique) and eleven grandchildren. Ron hasn’t slowed down since retiring last December; he’s actively involved in humanitarian work with A Better World, teaches Sabbath School, is a member of the Burman and PAA Alumni Council, is working on writing a book, and enjoys making lunch for Nicole every day.

Lalitha (Ramalingam) Taylor spent her childhood and teen years growing up on the Burman hilltop and attended College Heights Christian School, Parkview Adventist Academy and Burman University. After being diagnosed with rheumatoid arthritis at 19, Lalitha's desire to help prevent and manage her disease as well as provide individuals with a greater quality of health and life, prompted her to become a registered dietitian. In 2005, Lalitha completed her Bachelor of Science in Nutrition and Food Science along with an accredited dietetic internship through the University of Alberta. She is a senior dietitian with Edmonton Southside Primary Care Network in addition to offering private nutrition services through her own company.

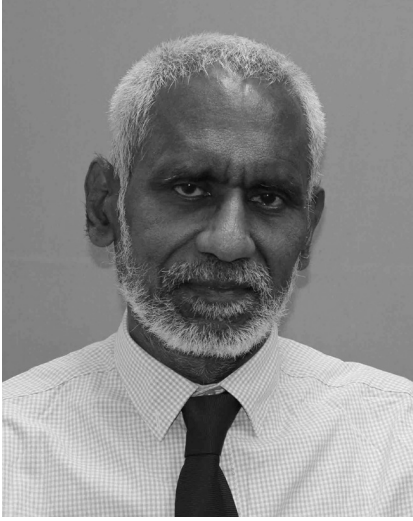
As a national spokesperson for the nearly 6,000 members of Dietitians of Canada, Lalitha regularly contributes to radio, print and media events including CTV2's Alberta Primetime and Global News. She has created educational videos that are disseminated throughout Alberta hospitals and medical clinics, volunteered at public hospitals in Peru and South Africa and has developed and presented hundreds of nutritional presentations for patients and corporate clientele.

Lalitha has won numerous awards for her work and volunteer contributions including an Edmonton Top 40 Under 40 designation, Dietitians of Canada Association Catalyst Award, a University of Alberta Alumni Horizon Award and Preceptor Recognition Award through the College of Dietitians of Alberta. She donates much of her time to her local community through Youth Empowerment and Support Services, The Arthritis Society, Red Willow Community Church and the University of Alberta Nutrition program, where she mentors multiple university students annually.

Lalitha is passionate about strengthening community health through nutritional education and you can find her sharing her knowledge at clinics, schools, homeless shelters, churches and community organizations.

Tennyson Samraj has taught at Burman University for 28 years in the Philosophy, Religion and General Studies departments. The subjects he teaches include Philosophy of Mind, Philosophy of Religion and Philosophy of Law. He started his studies in India, where he earned a BA in Religion from Spicer University, and an MA in History and a PhD in Philosophy from Pune University.

Tennyson's notable contentment is being in the classroom. He strongly believes that "all education is for application." Students are first in his life. He teaches students to define and defend not only their point of view but others point of view or paradigm. He see students at Burman University as being intelligent, talented and committed to serve others. He sees himself privileged to serve with a committed staff and faculty dedicated to providing the best for the students.

Tennyson has travelled with his students around the world studying various paradigms that define different cultures. His travels have taken him to all the continents including setting foot on Antarctica. His hobbies include creating portraits of important people who have contributed much to society. He believes that when we see God's hand in everything that happens in life, such a life is worth living.

"My students have made me intellectually honest. They have made me the person I am today, because they have asked the questions that not only concern them but questions that should concern all of us. Exceptional Volunteer Service Award

Millie Snow



Webster's Dictionary's meaning of the word volunteer is "a person who voluntarily offers herself for a service or undertaking willingly and without pay." For many years, Millie Snow has freely given of herself in loving service for those in need. Apart from establishing a home, raising three energetic boys, assisting her husband in evangelism throughout North America and overseas, she has dedicated her life in loving ministry for others. In 2016, the City of Lacombe recognized her years of dedication, kindness, and community mindedness by honouring her with the "Lifetime Achievement Award."

Within the church, Millie has freely given of her time in Native Ministry, Pathfinder leadership, and assisting in cooking schools among other things. In Alberta, she saw a need for those less fortunate and established a soup kitchen in the Red Deer district, getting the Adventist churches in the surrounding area to participate in its operations. She opens the door of the soup kitchen for a shelter for the homeless during the winter months in Red Deer. She was invited by the churches in the cities of Edmonton, Calgary, Moscow, Russia and Latvia to help with the establishment of soup kitchens. In 2005, she was invited by the church to be general manager of the food bank and director of Lacombe's local Adventist thrift store. From the thrift store and food bank, she, along with the volunteers, have been instrumental in assisting people in need by supplying hundreds of hampers each month and by sending tons of clothing overseas. Take a walk with Millie in the city of Red Deer some evening and watch the homeless come to her with gratitude.

In a city in Europe, Millie, the pastor and the evangelist were walking across a large square. In the middle of the square lay a man passed out from too much drink. This was a very common sight in this particular city. The pastor and the evangelist walked on, but Millie stopped, sat down on the pavement beside him, put his head on her lap and would not leave him until the pastor got help. When the intoxicated man opened his eyes and saw Millie holding him, he simply said, "I see an angel." Then shall He answer them, saying, "Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me." Matt. 25:40
