

Work on campus during the summer and you could save money!

The Burman University <u>Summer Work Program</u> gives new and returning students the opportunity to work on campus during the summer. This opportunity includes a full rent rebate (minimum 30 hours worked per week) as well as eligibility for the <u>Summer Ministries</u> <u>Scholarship</u>, a value of up to \$1000 per school year.

How it works:

- If you work for 30 or more hours per week on campus during the summer, your rent from Riverton Hall will rebated back onto your student account.
- A 30% matching scholarship up to a maximum of \$1000 is available on summer earnings that are applied to your Burman account during the summer months.

ELIGIBILITY:

New Students

- Must be accepted into Burman University for the upcoming school term starting in September.
- Must have completed budgeting with the Student Financial Services Office for the upcoming school term starting September

Continuing Students

- Must have pre-registered for full time attendance in the upcoming school term starting in September.
- Must have completed financial budgeting for the upcoming school term starting in September.

Graduating/Non-returning Students
