

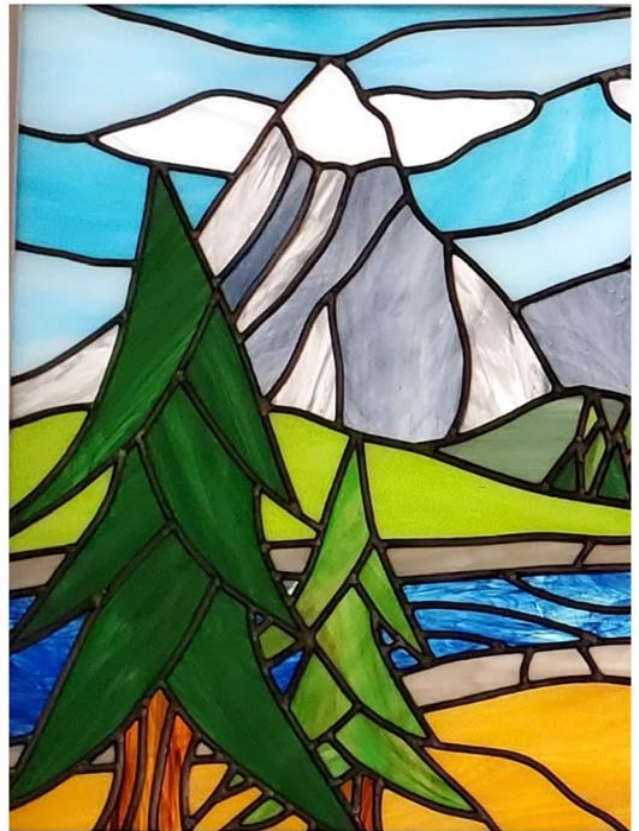

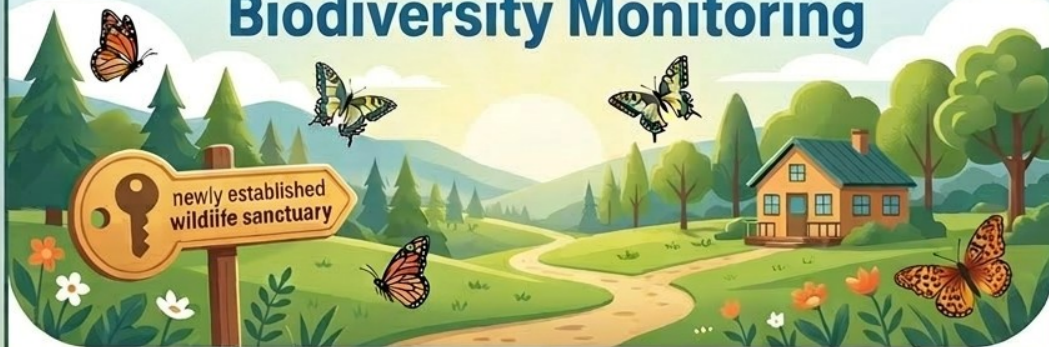

Summer Field Research Assistant – Biodiversity Monitoring



1. JOIN THE TEAM!

Overview: Join a long-term ecological monitoring project at a brand-new wildlife sanctuary! We are looking for a motivated undergraduate to assist with butterfly surveys and insect collection. This is your chance to gain professional experience from the ground up.



2. KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:



Butterfly Surveys: Conduct visual transect counts to identify & record local species.



Invertebrate Sampling: Manage & collect data from a light trap (dusk-to-dawn).



Data Management: Maintain meticulous field notes; develop & enter data into a database.



Specimen Handling: Assist in collection, sorting & preservation for identification.



3. What You'll Gain



Professional Training: Comprehensive training in entomological field methods and species identification.



Research Credit: Experience that can be leveraged for future graduate school applications or careers in conservation.



Impact: Your work will help shape the management plan for a brand-new sanctuary.



3. REQUIREMENTS:



Current Undergraduate Status: (Preference to Biology/Environmental Science majors).



Transportation: Valid driver's license & reliable access to a vehicle (sanctuary near Burman, but equipment needs transport).
