- For a full refund, withdraw by September 16, 2019.
- For a 75% refund, withdraw between September 17 and September 30, 2019.
- For a 50% refund, withdraw between October 1 and October 30, 2019.
- There will be no refund after October 30, 2019.

WINTER SEMESTER

- For a full refund, withdraw by January 17, 2020.
- For a 75% refund, withdraw between January 18 and January 31, 2020.
- For a 50% refund, withdraw between February 1 and March 2, 2020.
- There will be no refund after March 2, 2020.
