EDCI 305 – Teaching for Truth and Reconciliation

COURSE DESCRIPTION

An exploration of Indigenous worldviews, human rights issues, and impacts of European contact particularly on education. The course provides an opportunity to connect with local Indigenous people and their history with the intent to take actions toward reconciliation. The meaning of Truth and Reconciliation in the context of Christianity is explored.

This class is organized around 4 modules and some introductory work. The student is required to begin the class in June and complete the readings, videos and assignments by July 22 (a one week grace period will follow in consultation with the lead professor). Each module should be started and completed before moving on to the next module.
