- Total award amount will be divided equally between the two semesters of the school year.
- Recipient must attend full time for both semesters to realize the full value of any award.
- The student must register for, and successfully complete, a minimum 60% course load (9 credits excluding PLAR & Audit credits) each semester.
- If a student withdraws below the minimum 60% course load all scholarships will be reversed for that term.
- If you have an assessed disability status you may be eligible to receive scholarships at a 40% courseload or 6 credits per semester. If you are going to be a December 2021 or an April 2022 graduate you may petition for special circumstances in your final term.
