The successful candidate will have demonstrated success teaching introductory French and Intermediate French courses to a diverse student population across a range of programs. The successful candidate should have experience teaching online. Successful applicants will teach two courses in French in each semester (fall: FREN 101 Elementary French I and FREN 201 Intermediate French I; winter: FREN 102 Elementary French II and FREN 202 Intermediate French II). This is a limited-term position. Faculty will be required to teach on campus and/or online (with synchronous instruction).</p> <p>The successful candidate will have a strong commitment to Christian higher education, and be a dedicated Seventh-day Adventist Christian committed to integrating his or her faith with teaching and scholarship.
