 - (b) If returning after a break in full-time enrolment, have a previous Burman cum GPA of at least 2.0 with a minimum of 9 credits.
2. Preference given to those who demonstrate accomplishment in:
 - (a) Academic Achievement
 - (b) Community Service
 - (c) Campus Involvement
 - (d) Program Participation
