Scope: Students

Student Missionary

Burman University supports and promotes the work of the Student Missionaries. To ensure the success and safety of our Student Missionaries, the following criteria for a student to be approved by the Burman University President's Cabinet for a mission appointment must include all of the following:

- 1. Financial: The student's Burman bill must be paid in full (or as approved by the Student Finance Office) by the end of the current school year in which the student is applying to be an SM. Clearance is to be given by the Student Finance director.
- 2. Academic: The student must be in regular standing as a student with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00. Clearance to be given by the Registrar.
- 3. SM Meetings: The student must attend all regularly called SM meetings. Exceptions must be cleared with the campus chaplain.
- 4. Citizenship: The students will demonstrate model citizenship during his/her academic year.
- 5. Screening Committee Clearance: A positive recommendation must be given by the screening committee.

Once these five criteria have been met the name of the potential Student Missionary will then be submitted to the President's Cabinet for final approval from the institution.
