Scope: Students

Student Assault Crisis Plan

- 1. Contact respective administrator (Burman/PAA)
- 2. Contact RCMP (optional if over 18 years of age)
- 3. Contact parents (optional if over 18 years of age)
- 4. Offer immediate available support of deans, pastors, counselors
- 5. Call in a support person from counseling dept. for continued support
- 6. Contact Public Relations person to prepare statement of incidence to faculty/staff, students, and the press.
- 7. Faculty/staff notification by telephone Fan Out of a general meeting to be helped (specify date and time).
- 8. Student notification-by available advertising means
- 9. Follow-up with victim in offering support
- 10. Deal with the perpetrator, if applicable

Campus Concerns:

Some areas of campus that would assist in preventing assault crisis on campus would include:

- 1. Strengthening security
- 2. Campus lighting on all paved roadways
- 3. Education for measures of safety on a regular basis
- 4. Encourage development of community support network (Community Watch indicators in windows)

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
