- Other Activities (not specified elsewhere)

This process will:

- apply to all students registered in the CC activity program.
- operate as a simple threshold which is met when an applicant has attained 4 out of 7 skills
- promote engagement and well-roundedness
- highlight skills that enhance employability outcomes of students

This process will not:

- competitively rank students by the activities they undertake
- change a student's GPA or CGPA
- remove eligibility requirements for individual program participation.
